

Responsible Person and Safeguarding Manager

Aims

This course is designed to equip people with the skills and knowledge to understand the roles of 'Responsible Person' and Safeguarding Manager'.

Learning Outcomes:

- To raise awareness further on the whole issue of adult abuse.
- To understand the roles within the Safeguarding Adults procedures.
- To understand how to support staff raising concerns or suspicions of abuse.
- To increase confidence to make decisions in line with procedures.
- Develop a clear understanding about working in a multidisciplinary way.
- Develop an understanding of the legal framework.
- To understand the purpose of Safeguarding meetings within the procedures.
- To gain knowledge about monitoring requirements.

This course is open to managers or senior staff members i.e. Private Care Home Managers, Senior Carers, Senior Practitioners and Team Managers who would be required to undertake the role of Responsible Person or Safeguarding Manager when implementing the Safeguarding Adults Framework.
